- All authors and presenters are required to complete a conflict of interest disclosure.
- All presenters are required to register to attend the AIRA 2023 National Meeting and to pay the applicable registration fee.
- Abstracts should closely describe the material to be presented or covered.
- Please note that AIRA will have final content approval rights.

SUBMISSION OVERVIEW

AIRA invites meeting attendees to submit abstracts to be shared during the meeting's breakout sessions. These breakouts take place concurrently across multiple tracks based on topic.

A breakout session may include:

- 20-minute presentations
- 20-minute group discussions

AIRA invites submissions for the following:

	Presentation Length	Quick Definition
1 Breakout Session Presentation	20 minutes	Accepted presentations will be grouped into breakout sessions by meeting organizers. Presenters will each have 20 minutes for their presentation with additional time for Q&A incorporated into each session.
2 Lead a Group Discussion	20 minutes	Accepted discussion topics will be led by the submitter. Those leading the discussion will have 20 minutes to lead a group discussion during a breakout session.

BREAKOUT TOPICS FOR SUBMISSION

DATA EXCHANGE AND DATA SHARING

Real-life examples of the challenges and successes of data reporting and data sharing; best practices supporting data reporting; provider site onboarding and participation; data visualization; bulk query and data lakes; data sharing with non traditional partners.

IMMUNIZATION DATA AND PRACTICES

Innovative ways to improve the quality and completeness of immunization data and upgrade infrastructure and data practices; reminder/recall; leveraging current funding opportunities for IIS; data modernization.

OUTBREAK AND PANDEMIC RESPONSE

Monkeypox response, COVID-19 lessons learned, and best practices; sustainability; vaccine administration tools and IIS integration (e.g., VAMS, PrepMod); vaccine credentialing; consumer access to IIS; etc.

SYSTEMS INTEGRATION

Successful ways of integrating with other systems and programs such as the DMV, disease surveillance, Medicaid, Smarty, US postal service forwards, PPRL, IZ Gateway/IIS-IIS exchange, etc.

OTHER

Although so much of our recent work has been focused on responding to monkeypox and COVID-19, we'd still love to hear about the other work that is crucial to the IIS community. If your content doesn't fit any of the topics, this category is for you.
